

Impulse

In many countries, persons with disabilities continue to face discrimination and intolerance in their daily lives. They rarely have the opportunity to travel or share their needs, interests and abilities with others who are in similar situations. Events that truly put the target group at the centre from the outset are still lacking.

This congress's success is driven by the unpaid efforts of individuals, but cooperation with local organizations, authorities, universities, the media, and the public also contributes to its growth.



Development

The first congress took place in Berlin in 1998, followed by six more major European congresses under the motto 'Living in the Encounter'. Up to 700 people attended each event.

Since 2009, efforts have been made to expand the congress movement beyond Europe to other countries. As a result, congress series have been developed in various places, such as South America, Russia, India, and Thailand. In 2017, the first World Congress was held in Yekaterinburg, Russia. Around 850 participants from all continents travelled to the event.
